Rules and Regulations

ProAm Rules and Regulations

Events at this competition are sanctioned by DanceSport BC (DSBC). All competitors must sign the waiver on the back of this form to be eligible to compete.

Events may be cancelled at the discretion of the organizers if there are insufficient entries.

ProAm registration is done through paper form only.

Deadline for competitor entries is **February 23rd, 2024**. There will be a late entry fee of \$20 for all entries received and accepted after the entry deadline. Entries will only be accepted after the entry deadline if it does not necessitate further rounds. No entries will be accepted on the day of the event unless otherwise stated. UBC Dance Club member pricing is not available for ProAm events. For more information or online registration, please visit the UBC Dance Club website at www.ubcdanceclub.com/gala. General Rules

1. Events will be run according to DanceSport BC (DSBC) Bylaws and Rules.
2. Competitors should familiarize themselves with the rules prior to the competition.
3. Syllabus events will be invigilated.
4. Events will be cancelled or combined if there are insufficient entries.
5. All competitors or their legal guardians must sign the waiver on the front of this form to be eligible to compete. Competitors under 19 years of age MUST have this release signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Entry Fees

1. **ProAm Payment** and the **signed registration form** must be received by Pinky Wong at #202 – 8168 Granville St, Vancouver, BC, V6P 4Z4 by **February 23rd, 2024**. Payment is payable by cash or cheque addressed to UBC Dance Club % UBC Alma Mater Society. Online registration will not be available. Please see pricing and registration details below. 2. Pricing for each event is as follows:
 - a) ProAm Solo Routines: \$65 each
 - b) ProAm Formation Team: \$80 Each
 - c) ProAm Single Dance Events: \$20 per event per couple
 - d) ProAm Multi Dance Events:
 1. 2 dance events: \$40 per event per couple
 2. 3 dance events: \$60 per event per couple
 3. 4 dance events: \$80 per event per couple
 4. 5 dance events: \$100 per event per couple

Registration

1. The organizers reserve the right to cancel or combine levels and categories due to insufficient entries.
2. In any category with fewer than three entries, the organizer reserves the right to eliminate the age divisions and merge competitors into one open division.
3. Couples must check in at registration together, pick up their numbers and sign the waiver forms.
4. The schedule is subject to change, and events can run up to an hour ahead of posted times.
5. There is a \$5 refundable deposit for competition numbers. Please have \$5 cash ready when registering at the competition.

Judging of Events

1. Single or Multi-Dance Syllabus Competitions - Newcomer to Open Gold: these events comprise students dancing with their teachers in competition with other students. Only the students (and not the teachers) are judged.
2. in Open Championship Competitions, the couple will be judged (both teacher and student)

Age Restrictions and Proficiency levels for Single or Multi-Dance Competitions - Syllabus to Championship

1. Students may compete in multiple age groups with no restrictions, provided that they always qualify for those age groups.
2. All students are permitted to compete in two consecutive proficiency levels, e.g. Open Bronze and Silver, Silver and Open Silver, or Open Gold and Championship.
3. All syllabus levels for Single or Multi-Dance competitions – Newcomer to Gold, will be invigilated.
4. In Open Bronze, Open Silver and Open Gold events, couples are allowed to dance steps in a higher level e.g. in Open Bronze, couples can dance up to Silver syllabus and in Open Silver, up to Gold syllabus. Open Gold can dance up to Championship figures.
